Downloading CuVee Software Programs

into Magnetic Card-based Apps


(RPN-65, -67, -97)

The walk-through below assumes that you've set **Safari's Downloads folder** to your *iPhone* or *iPad*. The steps are essentially the same if you prefer *iCloud Drive* (which has the advantage that the files will be accessible from any of your devices.)

To define the **location** of the Downloads folder:

- Go to Settings > Safari > Downloads and check your download location.
- Choose On My iPhone (or On My iPad) for this walk-through.

In the **Files app**, you should see something like this. Note that you can **rename** the **Downloads folder** by long-pressing on it. Similarly, you can make it appear under **Favourites**.



The Task

On your **iPad**, download the program "**RPN Shopping App**" – found in the **Miscellaneous** section of **LibraryU** on the RPN-67 website (https://www.cuveesoft.ch/rpn67/p11.html) – into **RPN-97 Pro**.


On the web page in Safari, tap the **Download Card** button. Confirm by tapping **Download** in the dialog.




Tap Safari's download button, then the program name:



You're taken to the **Downloads folder**:



Tap the ZIP file to uncompress it:




Note:


At this point, you may – as an **alternative method** – *long-press* the file, then choose *Share*, then *Mail* to email it to yourself. After receiving the email, tap the icon in the message to import the program.


In this walk-through, we're going to move the unzipped file to RPN-97 Pro's documents folder.

We do this by long-pressing the file, then choosing Move.



Destinations for the move are presented. Select RPN-97 Pro, then tap Move (top-right):






Select On My iPad under Locations (iPhone: tap Back), and tap the RPN-97 Pro folder to open it.

You'll see the moved file **RPN_Shopping.rpn97**, ready for import into RPN-97 Pro.

Recents

(You'll also see three files containing **sqlite** in their names. These are the database files holding all your programs. **Don't tamper with them!** If you delete the files, RPN-97 Pro will revert to the default database. On the other hand, it's always a good idea to keep a backup copy of these files in a safe place.)


Browse



We're done! Tap the file **RPN_Shopping.rpn97**, and RPN-97 Pro will open.

Go to a card to overwrite, or create a new one, then tap the **Share** button.

Choose Import from Files and tap Write Card to save the data to the card.



NOTE

The action **Import from Files** picks the **alphabetically first** program it finds.

If you have several files ready for import, you may **rename** the file you're interested in, for example by starting its name with the number 1. (*Long-press* the file icon.) This will not affect the title of the program.
